- US Navy Ship Action Reports and Deck Logs
- Army/Air Force Morning Reports and Rosters
- Air Forces Mission reports and histories
- Operation, After Action, and Ground Unit reports and journals

TIPS FOR RESEARCH

- Search your veteran's unit name to find privately maintained sites dedicated to specific units and their histories
- Out of copyright/print memoirs and unit histories can be found on Google Books
- Subscription based research sites can generally be accessed through your local library
- Remember to check local sources and state specific records for mentions of your veteran
