

# Tracing Immigrants to New York

## Report of the activities of the scholar in residence relating to resources within the New York Genealogical and Biographical Society's collections

### Overview

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January 2025 Karen Kowallis was appointed as the NYG&B's 2025 scholar in residence to focus on NYG&B resources for tracing immigrants. Ms. Kowallis surveyed and identified specific groups covered within the NYG&B's collections relating to immigrants to New York between 1840 and 1924.

### Objective

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To survey and identify specific groups covered within the NYG&B's collections relating to immigrants to New York between 1840 and 1924.

- Manuscript and print collections from the NYG&B housed at the NYPL, including various abstracts, transcriptions, and compiled genealogies.
- All published issues of the *NYG&B Record*.
- Online collections and articles published by the NYG&B through its website.
- Lectures, articles, and other relevant items located in the NYG&B's internal archives.

The end project includes a report and a bibliography identifying different immigrant groups.

### Organization of Bibliography

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The Bibliography is organized into six sections:

- German Resources
- Irish Resources
- Resources for Other Ethnicities
- New York City Resources
- New York Counties and Statewide Resources
- General Research Resources

And each section is broken up into five subsections:

- Online records (including the *NYG&B Record*)
- Manuscript collections/Locality Files/Subject Files/Genealogical Research files
- Books at the NYPL
- Maps
- Materials at NYGB

## Online Records

The NYG&B website includes record collections, bibliographies, articles, guides, webinars, and publications. Searches for Ireland/Irish, Germany/German, Italy/Italian were conducted and added. Search terms for “immigration” and “naturalization” were used.

## The NYG&B Record

All published issues of the *NYG&B Record* were surveyed. Early issues identified that the purpose of the *NYG&B Record* was to document the families of the early settlers of New York.

The Editorial remarks in the January 1999 issue (Volume 130), identified it as the first issue that included a focus family that immigrated during the “Great Wave.”

While the *NYG&B Record* did not have many case studies for immigrant families, it did include a large number of other resources. Many contributions included tombstone inscriptions and church records. The tombstone inscriptions are a valuable resource because many stones are made of material that doesn’t weather well and may not be legible today. The *NYG&B Record* also includes transcriptions of church, many in NYC. Immigrants arriving in the US between 1840-1924 lived throughout the state of New York and can be found in many of these record sets that were published in the *NYG&B Record*.

In the last 25 years, the *NYG&B Record* has published more stories highlighting people who immigrated between 1840 and 1924. The case studies can be useful education tools.

## Manuscript Collections, Locality Files, Subject Files, Genealogical Research Files

The majority of the manuscript collection includes family files. The finding aids to the various collections were read to determine if any might be useful for those researching immigrant families. The majority of the family files had evidence that the immigrant ancestor came before 1840.

One item included in the Klefeker and Saxer Family Papers was a journal written in German. An English translation was also included which described the political climate in Berlin between 1844-1881 and how it impacted the family. This journal could be a great item for anyone researching those who came from Berlin in that time period.

The manuscript collection was searched for any ledger books, church books, or similar records that would hold records for a diverse population. There were a few ledgers, a few church record books, and copies of marriage records that were found.

The Subject Files (NYGB Subject 2009-001) consist of six boxes with approximately thirty folders in each box. They were surveyed in their entirety.

The Localities Files (MssCol NYGB 18357) consist of six boxes with approximately fifteen folders in each box. They were surveyed in their entirety.

The Locale Files (NYGB Loc 2008-001) consist of 51 boxes. Due to time constraints, only the folders containing files for NYC (any borough) were surveyed.

### **Books at the NYPL**

The book collection at NYPL has tens of thousands of books. Surveying all of the books was not possible. Key words for different immigration groups, such as those coming from Ireland or German area, were used to locate books that could help those researching immigrant ancestors.

The focus of this project was primarily on unpublished materials, and the book collection only received minimal inspection.

### **Maps at the NYPL**

The map collection was evaluated online. Viewing the maps in detail was not possible due to the time constraints and viewing limitations as described in the limitations section above. There was a large collection of maps for Ireland, containing a map for each county in Ireland. These maps were reproductions of 1901 maps. There were several NYC maps, as well as maps all over the state of New York. Some of these maps are available elsewhere online but many are not.

### **Resources at the NYG&B Office**

The resources held at the NYG&B office were surveyed in their entirety, with the exception of the complete collection of the Kinship materials. Only a portion of the collection was surveyed.
